
Working towards Quality Eye Care




SSEH joins MP Nursing Home Association

Eye & Dental Camp

For the benefit of the people of Bhopal, Sewa Sadan Eye Hospital organised a series of free eye and dental camps at different venues at the heart of the city.

Since the month of May, three such camps have been held. One at Borvan Club on 27th May; Ekant Park on 12th June and at Swarna Jayanti Park on 13th June. A total of 486 people availed of the benefit. Doctors and health workers used this opportunity to check blood pressure and screen for diabetes.

Eye doctor, Dr. Aishwarya Raghuvanshi and senior optometrist on examination at the camp detected cases of refractive error which requires using spectacles and of cataract, which requires further treatment. Dentist at SSEH Dr. Komal Daswani did the dental checkup.

OTHER CAMPS

Eye camps are a way of taking eye care to people's doorstep. Its a common attitude found in many to defer a check up which can save sight. SSEH regularly conducts such camps.

Cash Management System supports us regularly for eye camps. One was held on 30th May 2023 at Anna Nagar, Bhopal. In the camp, 116 people were screened, 32 spectacles dispensed and 4 cataract surgeries advised.





Bhopal Utsav Mela Samiti had organized a camp at Manas Bhawan Bhopal on June 25, 2023. 190 patients were screened, 34 were identified with cataract and 24 were admitted for surgery.

On World Blood Donor Day observed on 14 June annually 16 employees of SSEH donated blood at Bhopal Blood Centre.


New Course Introduced

An early diagnose and treatment saved sight for Anjali & Lucky

Cataract is the leading cause of childhood blindness in developing countries. Early detection and treatment of childhood cataracts can reduce the burden of blindness in the nation. In Asia, the incidence of childhood blindness is more than one million, and the most common cause of this is pediatric cataract. A developing nation like India contributes 7.4-15.3% of the total incidence of blindness, which reduces those children's quality-adjusted life years. Childhood blindness can be reduced by early diagnosis and prompt treatment. *

Lucky and Anjali fall among the fortunate whose cataract was detected early, and a successful surgery restored their vision to lead a normal life.

At a young age, siblings Anjali 18 years and Lucky 14 years were found to have weak eyesight. Their vision was hazy making it difficult for them to see clearly. This affected all spheres of their lives. They could not play with their friends. At school, they did not fare too well as visual impairment hampered their ability to read study materials and written assignments.



Anjali and Lucky's parents - father, Mr. Jitendra Dhanak an auto-rickshaw driver, and mother, Mrs. Savita worked as a maid in a college were financially not well off. They lived near Neelbad, in Bhopal district of Madhya Pradesh.

Seeing their children suffer and concerned about their deteriorating eyesight Mr Dhanak decided to seek medical help. He took them to Sewa Sadan Eye Hospital's vision centre at Neelbad. On examination, both Lucky and Anjali were diagnosed with bilateral developmental cataract. The teenagers were referred for further examination and possible surgery at the base hospital in Bhopal.

On June 9, 2023, Lucky and Anjali underwent cataract surgery at the base hospital. Following successful surgeries, the siblings' visual acuity improved significantly, enhancing their quality of life and providing them with the opportunity to pursue their education.
